RURAL GOVERNMENT ORDINANCE (Cap. 132)

(PIG CONTROL) BY-LAWS, 1956 (G.N.S. 120 of 1956)

In exercise of the powers conferred upon it by paragraph (7) of subsection (1) of section 15 of the Rural Government Ordinance, and all powers thereunto it enabling, the Kota Belud Local Authority has made the following By-laws which have been approved by the Resident:-

- 1. These By-laws may be cited as the Kota Belud Local Authority (Pig Control) By-laws, 1956.
- 2. All pigs within the Kota Belud Local Authority area shall be kept penned at all times.
- **3.** All persons keeping pigs in the areas lying within a half mile of the following roads shall keep such pigs continuously penned:-
 - (1) Kota Belud to Ranau Road: so far as Mile 10 from Kota Belud.
 - (2) Pindasan to Langkon Road: as far as Mile 19 from Kota Belud.
 - (3) Kota Belud to Kota Kinabalu Road: that part of the road which lies within the local area.
 - (4) Kota Belud Tempasuk Road.
 - (5) Kota Belud Sorob Road.
 - (6) Kota Belud Tambulian Road.

- (7) Kota Belud Bangkahak Road.
- **4.** Any person failing to comply with these By-laws shall be liable to a fine of twenty-five ringgit for a first offence and to a fine of one hundred ringgit for a second or subsequent offence.
