LOCAL GOVERNMENT ORDINANCE, 1961 (No. 11 of 1961)

KOTA BELUD DISTRICT COUNCIL (STREETS AND PUBLIC PLACES) BY-LAWS, 1964 (G.N.L. 40 of 1964)

In exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 50 of the Local Government Ordinance, 1961, and all other powers thereunto it enabling, the Kota Belud District Council has made the following By-laws:-

Title and commencement.

1. These By-laws may be cited as the Kota Belud District Council (Streets and Public Places) By-laws, 1964, and shall come into operation on the 1st day April, 1964.

Interpretation.

2. In these By-laws, "streets" and "public place" mean streets and public places under the control of or vested in the Council.

Removal of barriers etc.

3. No person not authorised by the Council shall take down, alter or remove any barrier, signs or lights placed by the Council across or in any street.

Blind etc. not to encroach street or public places.

4. No person shall hang any blind, awning or other structure from any building such as to encroach on to any street or public place.

Trees not to be damaged or removed.

5. No person shall damage or remove any tree or vegetation growing along any street or

in any public place.

Maintenance of walls etc.

6. The owner or occupier of any premises shall keep his wall, fence, post or gate

bordering on any street or public place in a good state of repair.

Parking of vehicles.

7. No person shall, unless permitted by the Council, park his vehicle in any public place,

and no person shall repair or mend any vehicle in any street or public place.

Penalty.

8. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of these By-laws shall be guilty of

an offence and shall be liable to a fine of two hundred and fifty ringgit.
