LOCAL GOVERNMENT ORDINANCE 1961 (No. 11 of 1961)

(FOOD AND EATING PREMISES) BY-LAWS 1965 (G.N.L 21 of 1965)

In exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 50 of the Local Government Ordinance 1961, the Kudat District Council has made the following by-laws:

Title and commencement.

1. These by-laws may be cited as the Kudat Town Board (Food and Eating Premises) By-laws 1965 and shall come into operation on the 1st day of February 1965.

Licences.

2. No person shall carry on the business of a cookshop, eating-shop, coffee shop, food stall, restaurant or bakery except in accordance with a licence granted by the Board.

Application for licence.

3. An application for a licence shall be in writing and shall be accompanied by two photographs of the applicant.

Grant of licence.

4. The Board may, in its absolute discretion, grant or refuse a licence, or grant a licence subject to such conditions as it thinks fit.

Health certificate.

5. If the Board so requires, an applicant for a licence or for a renewal thereof shall forward a certificate of health from a Government Medical Officer or registered medical practitioner.

Duration of licence.

6. Licences may be issued for a month, a quarter or a year.

Fee.

7. The fee for a licence shall be fifteen ringgit per month payable in advance

Licence not to be transferred.

8. No licensee shall transfer or otherwise part with the possession of his licence to any unauthorised person.

Penalty.

9. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of these By-laws shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable to a fine of five hundred ringgit.

Cancellation of licence.

- **10.** The Board may cancel or suspend a licence
 - (a) if the licensee or any assistant of the licensee
 - (i) is convicted of any offence under these By-laws; or
 - (ii) is convicted of any offence under any written law relating to public health or the use of false weights or measures in respect of goods to which the licence relates; or
 - (b) if, on the certificate of a Government Medical Officer or a registered medical practitioner, the licensee is suffering from a contagious or infectious disease.
