LOCAL GOVERNMENT ORDINANCE 1961 (No. 11 of 1961)

KUDAT TOWN BOARD (STREETS AND PUBLIC PLACES) BY-LAWS 1965 (G.N.L 27 of 1965)

In exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 50 of the Local Government Ordinance 1961, the Kudat District Council has made the following by-laws:

Title and commencement.

1. These by-laws may be cited as the Kudat Town Board (Streets and Public Places) By-laws 1965 and shall come into operation on the 1st day February 1965.

Interpretation.

2. In these By-laws, "streets" and "public places" mean streets and public places under the control of or vested in the Board.

Removal of barriers, etc..

3. No person not authorised by the Board shall take down, alter or remove any barrier, signs or lights placed by the Board across or in any street.

Blind, etc., not to encroach street or public places.

4. No person shall hang any blind, awning or other structure from any building such as to encroach on to any street.

Trees not to be damaged or removed.

5. No person shall damage or remove any tree or vegetation growing along any street or in any public place.

Maintenance of walls, etc..

6. The owner or occupier of any premises shall keep his wall, fence, post or gate bordering on any street in a good state of repair.

Parking of vehicles.

7. No person shall, unless permitted by the Board, park his vehicle in any street or public place.

Penalty.

8. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of these By-laws shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable to a fine of five hundred ringgit.
