THE PUBLIC HEALTH ORDINANCE, 1960 (Ordinance No. 7 of 1960)

LABUAN TOWN BOARD (CONSERVANCY AND HYGIENE) BY-LAWS,1968

In exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 132 of the Public Health Ordinance, 1960 [Ord. No. 7 of 1960.], the Labuan Town Board (hereinafter referred to as the Board) has made the following By-laws:-

Title and commencement.

1. These by-laws may be cited as the Labuan Town Board (Conservancy and Hygiene) By-laws, 1968, and shall come into operation on the 1st day of July, 1968.

Collection of refuse.

- **2.** (1) Every owner or occupier of a building shall provide and use a covered metal dust bin approved by the Board for the collection of house refuse from his premises.
- (2) The Board may specify the places at which dust bin shall be placed for facilitating the removal of their contents by the Board.

Trade refuse.

- **3.** (1) The owner or occupier of any building or premises used for business shall cause all trade refuse to be collected or removed in such manner as the Board may direct.
- (2) The Board may, upon the failure of the owner or occupier to do so, collect or remove the trade refuse and charge the owner or occupier for the service in such amount as the Board decides.

Dumping of refuse.

4. No person shall dump or leave refuse in any place not authorised by the Board for that purpose.

Carrying of offensive substance.

5. No person shall carry nightsoil, liquid manure or other offensive substance in any public place except in a covered receptacle approved by the Board and at times approved by the Board.

Dead animals.

- **6.** The occupier of any premises in which an animal is found dead shall cause the same to be buried forthwith. The carcass of such animal shall not be used for human consumption or sold for that purpose.
- **7.** (a) No person may keep any animal or bird within the Town Board area or within a specified place within a Town Board area in contravention of a prohibitive notice of the Board.

(b) Every place in which horses, ponies, cattle or pigs, mules, goats, sheep are kept shall be constructed, fenced and drained to the satisfaction of the Board. Such place shall be provided with such supply of water as the Board may direct. The owner of such premises shall maintain always in a clean and sanitary condition.

Penalty.

8. (1) Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of these By-laws shall be guilty of an offence and be liable to a fine of one hundred dollars.

Repeal and Replacement. [See L. 20/68.]

9. Part XVII of the Labuan Town Board (General) By-laws, 1957 is repealed.
