# THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ORDINANCE, 1961 (Ordinance No. 11 of 1961)

LABUAN TOWN BOARD (LAUNDRIES) BY-LAWS, 1968

In exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 50 of the Local Government Ordinance, 1961 [Ord. No. 11 of 1961], the Labuan Town Board (hereinafter referred to as the Board) has made the following By-laws: -

#### Title and commencement.

**1.** These By-laws may be cited as the Labuan Town Board (Laundries) By-laws, 1968, and shall come into operation on the 1st day of July, 1968.

#### Licence for laundry and dry-cleaning.

2. No person shall use any premises as a laundry or for dry cleaning except in accordance with a licence granted by the Board.

# Application for licence.

**3.** An application for a licence shall be in writing and shall specify the business and the premises on which the applicant proposes to carry on the business.

#### Grant of licence.

**4.** The Board may, in its absolute discretion, grant or refuse a licence, or grant a licence subject to such conditions as it thinks fit. Such licence shall be in the form of the First Schedule to these By-laws.

# Health certificate.

- **5.** (1) An applicant for a licence or for the renewal of a licence shall forward to the Board a certificate of health in the form of the Second Schedule hereto from a Government Medical Officer or registered medical practitioner. Such certificate shall be endorsed annually or more often, if so required by the Board.
- (2) All persons engaged in laundry or dry cleaning on the licensee's premises shall likewise produce Health Certificate in the manner set out in By-law 5 (1).

#### **Duration of licence.**

**6.** All licences shall, subject to the provisions of these By-laws, expire on the 31st day of December of the year in which they are granted.

7. The monthly fee for a licence shall be fifty ringgit.

# Adequate water supply.

**8.** No premises shall be used for laundry or dry cleaning unless there is, in the opinion of the Board, an adequate supply of clean water.

#### No ejection of water from mouth or nose.

**9.** A licensee shall not eject or permit to be ejected water from the mouth or nose on to any clothes received for laundry or dry cleaning.

# Use of premises.

10. No person shall reside in any part of premises directly used for laundry or dry cleaning.

#### Clothes not to be worn.

11. No licensee shall wear or permit to be worn any clothes received for laundry or dry cleaning.

#### Disease.

**12.** No person suffering from a contagious or infectious disease shall be engaged in the business of a laundry or dry cleaning.

#### Infected clothes.

- **13.** A licensee or his assistant shall not receive clothes for laundry or dry cleaning from a person whom he knows to be suffering from a contagious, infectious or skin disease.
- **14.** A licensee shall comply with such direction as may be given by an officer of the Board for the purpose of maintaining the premises in a clean and sanitary condition.

# Penalty.

**15.** Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of these By-laws shall be liable to a fine of two hundred dollars.

#### Cancellation of licence.

- **16.** The Board may cancel or suspend a licence
  - (a) if the licensee or any assistant of the licensee is convicted of any offence under these By-laws; or
  - (b) if, on the certificate of a Government Medical Officer or a registered medical practitioner, the licensee is suffering from a contagious or infectious disease;
  - (c) on the certificate of a Government Medical Officer that the premises are a danger to public health.

# Repeal and Replacement. [See L. 20/68.]

17. Part IV of the Labuan Town Board (General) By-Laws, is repealed.
