The North Borneo Cession (Amendment) Order in Council 1950.

AT THE COURT AT BUCKINGHAM PALACE THE TWENTY-FIRST DAY OF JULY, 1950.

PRESENT:

THE KING'S MOST EXCELLENT MAJESTY IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS it is desirable to amend the provisions of the North Borneo Cession Order in Council, 1946, in the manner hereinafter appearing:

NOW, THEREFORE, His Majesty is pleased, by and with the advice of His Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:-

- 1. This Order may be cited as the North Borneo Cession (Amendment) Order in Council, 1950, and shall come into operation forthwith.
 - 2. The North Borneo Cession Order in Council, 1946, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section;
- "3A. Any person who was not a citizen of the State of North Borneo as provided by section 3 of this Order shall be deemed to have become a British subject on the fifteenth day of July, 1946, if
 - (a) he was born before the first day of November, 1931, in the State of North Borneo (otherwise than on a ship registered elsewhere than in the State) or on a ship registered in the State; and
 - (b) he was ordinarily resident in the Colony of North Borneo on the fifteenth day of July, 1946."
