PUBLIC HEALTH ORDINANCE 1960 (No. 7 of 1960)

PAPAR DISTRICT COUNCIL (OFFENSIVE TRADES) BY-LAWS 1977

(G.N.L 58 of 1977)

In exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 109 of the Public Health Ordinance 1960, and all other powers thereunto it enabling, the Papar District Council has made the following by-laws;

1. Title and commencement.

These by-laws may be cited as the Papar District Council (Offensive Trades) By-laws 1977 and shall come into operation on the 1st day of January 1978.

2. Fee. [Sub. G.N.L 9/84, G.N.L 14/88, G.N.L 10/90.]

The monthly licence fee to use a premises for the purpose of an offensive trade granted under subsection (2) of section 105 of the Public Health Ordinance 1960 shall be as follow-

3. Exhibition of licence.

Every holder of a licence shall exhibit such licence in a conspicuous place on the premises to which it relates so as to be visible to every person entering the premises.

4. Offensive products and materials.

No product, by-product or material used in connection with or resulting from an offensive trade shall be placed, spread or hung up to dry in any place within the following distance of any building used for human habitation —

- (a) in the case of the offensive trades of a skin storer, sauce manufacturer, blood boiler, blood cleaner, blood drier, glue maker, gut scraper, knacker, manure storer, skin curer, sago manufacturer, bone storer, bottle buyer, brick burner, charcoal burner, fat extractor, fat melter, feather dresser, fish curer, gut maker, insecticidal manufacture, lime burner, manure maker, rag and bone dealer, scrap rubber processer, size maker, soap boiler, tallow melter, tanner, trye processer a distance of thirty yards.
- (b) in the case of other offensive trades a distance of fifteen yards.

5. Penalty.

Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of these By-laws shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable to a fine of five hundred ringgit. [Mod. Act 160.]

6. Repeal. [G.N.S 93/56.]

Part IV of the Papar (Townships) (General) By-laws 1958 is hereby repealed.
