RURAL GOVERNMENT ORDINANCE (Cap. 132) PIG CONTROL (RANAU AREA) BY-LAWS 1956 (G.N.S 109 of 1956)

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section 56 and paragraph (1) of section 15 of the Rural Government Ordinance, the Resident, West Coast Residency, has made the following by-laws.

1. Title and application.

These by-laws may be cited as the Pig Control (Ranau Area) By-laws 1956 and shall apply in those areas lying within a quarter mile of the following areas-

- (1) Bundu Tuhan Dispensary
- (2) Ranau Township

or within a quarter mile of either side of the following paths and tracks

- (3) Ranau-Tenompok jeep track
- (4) Tenompok-Bundu Tuhan bridle-path
- (5) Ranau-Mensango bridle-path
- (6) Ranau-Poring jeep track
- (7) Ranau-Paginatan bridle-path

2. Pigs to be kept penned.

All persons keeping pigs shall keep such pigs continuously penned.

3. Penalty.

Any person failing to comply with these By-laws shall be liable to a fine of twenty-five ringgit for a first offence and to a fine of one hundred ringgit for a second or any subsequent offence.
